Have you verified the data on your FCC license lately?

Did you know that the FCC data on some licenses is often incomplete or inaccurate?

On April 15, 2003, the FCC delayed implementation of Part 101 coordination procedures for fixed point-to-point Broadcast Auxiliary Service (BAS) stations until October 16, 2003. This was done in an effort to give broadcasters additional time to update operational information in the FCC ULS system. With the impending coordination requirement, it is now more important than ever to have accurate and updated technical information in the FCC's licensing database.

Auditing Service

It is imperative that the technical information on a FCC license be accurate. The FCC data on BAS licenses is often incomplete or inaccurate. Worse yet, an operating system that you thought was licensed may not be. Inaccurate FCC data can increase the likelihood of potential interference into your system as well as others.

Did you know that you must file a System Construction Notice within 18 months of receiving a TV or aural BAS station license and 12 months of receiving a Remote Pickup BAS station license?

Monitoring Service

Many licensees risk losing assigned frequencies by missing FCC filing deadlines or failing to file FCC applications within 6 months of frequency coordination.
